above

This hero has super powers.

- Bellerophon is a **hero!**



kill

This spray kills bugs.

- The queen tells King Proteus, "**Kill** Bellerophon!"



note


He writes a note to his mom.

- King Lobates is **sad**.




scary

- “Higher! Higher!” **shouts** Bellerophon.




tail
