#### Baked Cricket Recipe

Crickets can make a delicious and nutritious snack. They are high in protein, calcium, and iron. And they have a nutty, shrimp-like flavor you will love. Here is recipe for crunchy baked crickets:

1. Preheat oven to 225°C.
2. Spread crickets evenly on a lightly-oiled baking sheet.
3. Bake in oven until the crickets become crispy and golden-brown, usually about 20 minutes.
4. Remove from the oven and let cool for 5 minutes.
5. Enjoy your snack!

Next time, try adding garlic, salt, or other spices before baking. The crunchy baked crickets also go well sprinkled on salads or mixed in with nuts.
