Introduction	Greeting and attendance Check completed homework	5
Review	Vocabulary Quiz for Unit 2 <ul style="list-style-type: none">- provide copies of quiz to students	5
Pre-reading	Warm-up <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - brainstorm vocabulary related to title and picture in the Warm-up activity - read the questions aloud and have students create responses; write responses on the board New Words <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - read the sentences and have students write the words in the correct blanks matching the context of the sentences with the content of the pictures - explain words that are unfamiliar to students 	5
Reading	Passage <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ask students to look at the picture and discuss what they see - listen to the audio track for the passage; have students track the words of the passage as they are spoken - listen again and pause the audio track after each sentence; have students repeat after the speaker for pronunciation practice - close the book and ask students to explain what they can remember; students may explain in their first language as long as the teacher is able to understand - in pairs, ask students to read the passage aloud to each other or have the students read silently and record their reading times below the passage 	10
Comprehension Checking	Checking <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - have students mark their answers and then check the activity together as a class 	15

	<p>Listening</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ask students to explain what they see in the picture for this activity - read the sentences and show students how answer choices match with the image - listen to the audio track and have student choose the sentence that they hear - check as a class - if time allows, have students look at the transcript at the back of the book and read along as they listen again; students may also repeat each sentence after the audio for pronunciation practice <p>Mapping</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - have students look at the image(s) and verbally explain what they see; images should match with content read in the reading passage - choose the letter of the answer choice for the blank in the activity - ask students to look back at the reading passage and underline the sentences that relate to the mapping activity 	
Consolidation	<p>Vocabulary Review</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - have students complete the activity and then check the activity together as a class <p>Summary</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - have students fill in the blanks with words from the word box - allow students to refer back to the passage as necessary to confirm their answers - check together as a class 	5
Closure	<p>Practice</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - allow students time to practice with word cards from this unit along with word cards from any previous units studied <p>Homework</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - assign homework in the workbook 	5
