Jegichagi is played especially by children. *Jegi* Ⓐ is made of an old coin and *hanji*, or traditional Korean paper. The player kicks a *jegi* up in the air. He keeps Ⓑ kicking it up before it falls down to the ground. The players Ⓒ usually use one foot to kick the *jegi* up, but they can use their two feet. In the one-player game, the winner is the player who kicks the *jegi* up the most times.

You can play it with your friends by making teams of more than two players and Ⓓ take turns kicking the *jegi* up. In Ⓔ another game, the players stand in a circle and take turns kicking the *jegi*. The loser is the player who can't kick up the *jegi*, and he gets some penalty. For example, he has to throw the *jegi* at the winner so that the winner can kick it away as he likes. When the loser catches the *jegi* with his hands, the penalty ends there.
